Anclote River West Watershed

Dear Property Owner:

The Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) with the cooperation of Pasco County is developing a Watershed Management Plan (Plan) in your area. Our consultants are collecting field data and other information to characterize the watershed.

A watershed is an area of land that water flows across as it moves toward a common body of water, such as a stream, river, lake, or coastal waters. The District is informing residents of the Plan through the mail and other media sources. Letters are being sent to selected property owners with parcel boundaries that intersect wetlands, areas currently designated as a special Flood Hazard "A" Zone on the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs), and areas adjacent to conveyance ways: ditches, creeks, and rivers. A letter is also being sent to all Homeowner Associations within the watershed to share with their residents.

The consulting firm of Ardaman and Associates, Inc. (Ardaman) is conducting data collection and analysis within the Anclote River West Watershed. Please share any photos of flooding within your area, your eyewitness accounts (observations) of where the water flows and where it flows during flooding events, high water marks, or other information.

This information, along with other physical features will be used as parameters in a computer model to simulate a storm event and how the watershed responds. With the results of the simulation the flood prone areas and floodplain are identified. The floodplain boundaries help communities manage floodplains, flood risks, and provide information to homeowners making decisions about protecting their property and planning for emergencies. Once approved, these boundaries will be used for floodplain management by Pasco County and SWFWMD.
